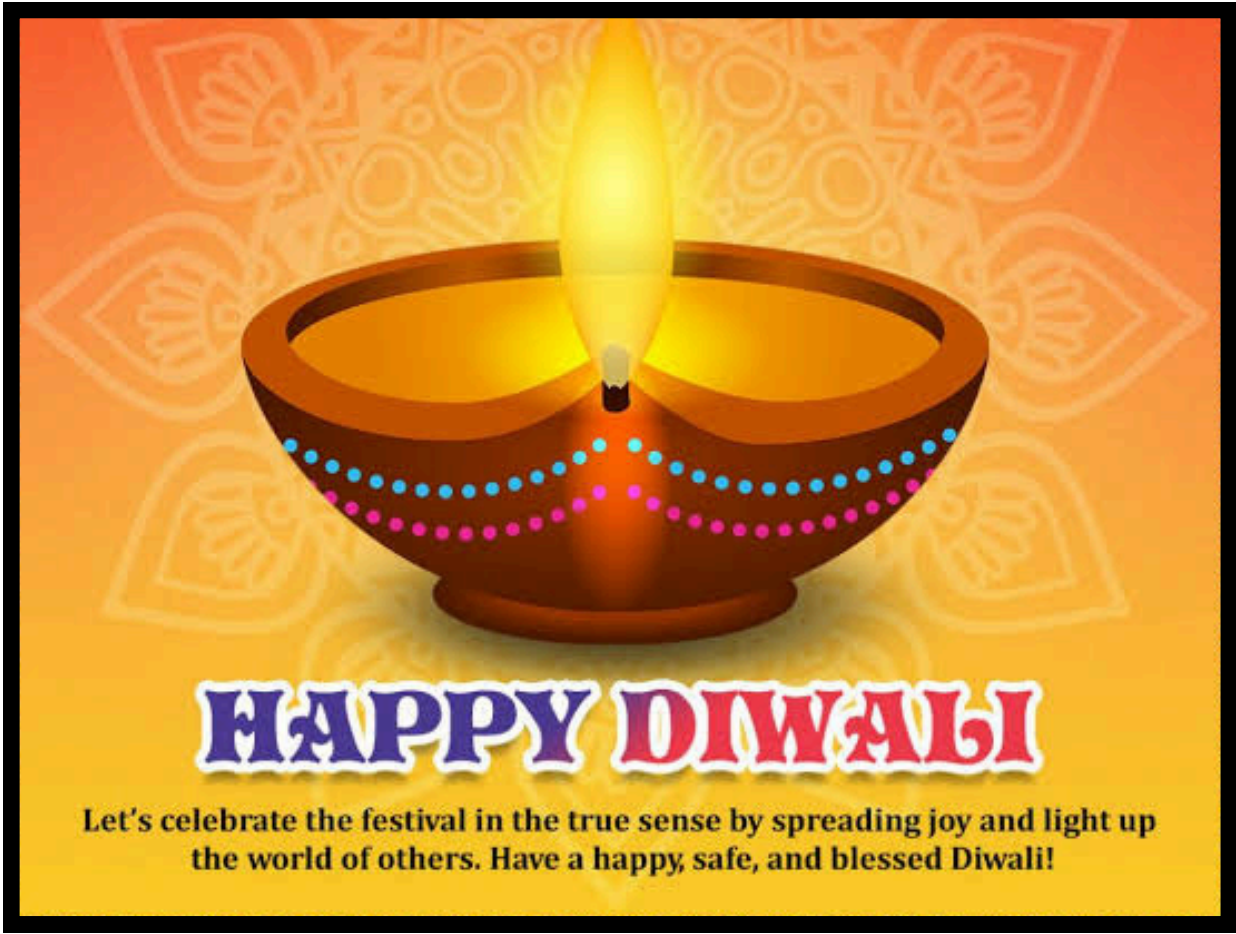
✦ *DIWALI FOR ALL: BCM SCHOOL SPREADS FESTIVE CHEER AMONG SUPPORT STAFF* ✦
