The UKG students, stepping into slightly more advanced territory, carried out a Neutralization Reaction experiment. Under guided supervision, they witnessed how acids and bases react to form a neutral solution, sparking early interest in chemistry.

## ***Stuti Mahajan Tops LSSC Drawing Contest***

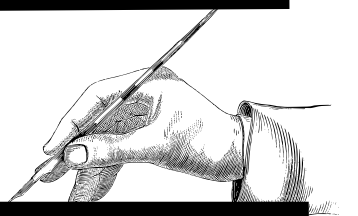

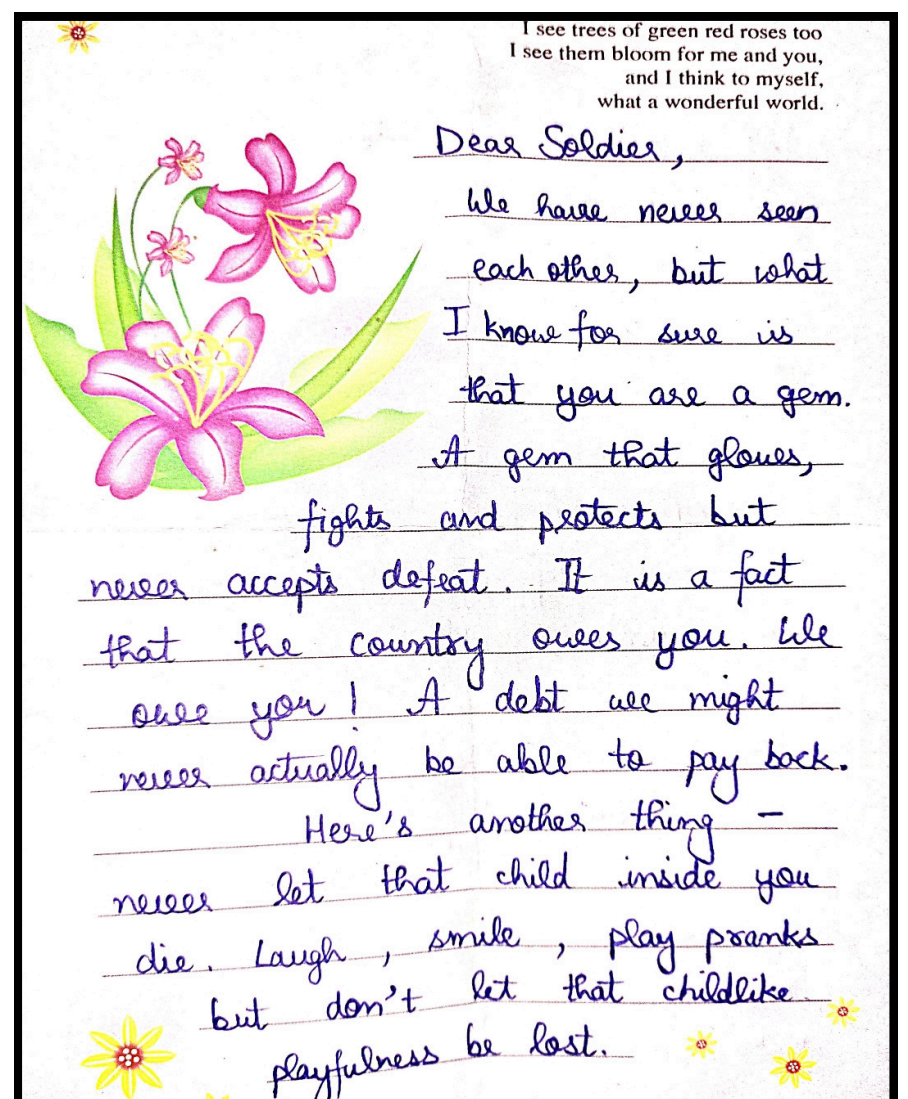
