### **1. Cyber Hygiene Campaign for Teachers**

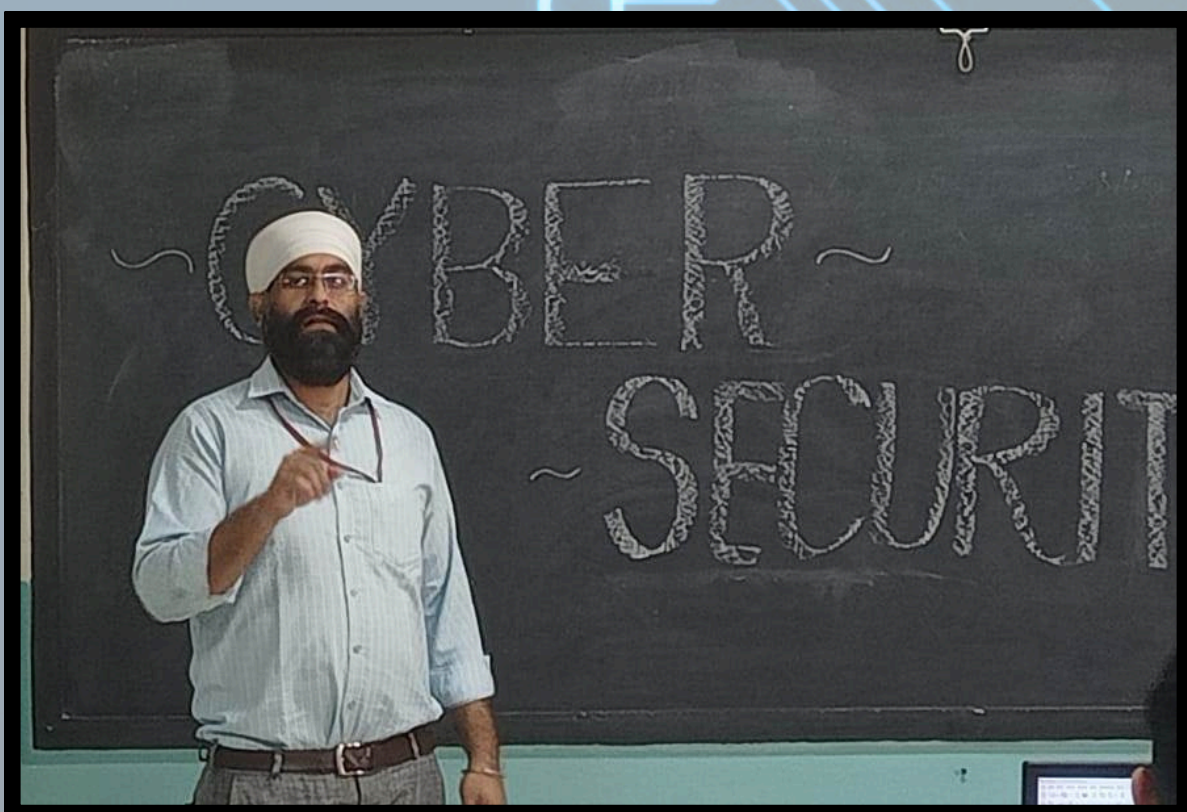
