COMPETITION TO CELEBRATE CULTURE AND TALENT**

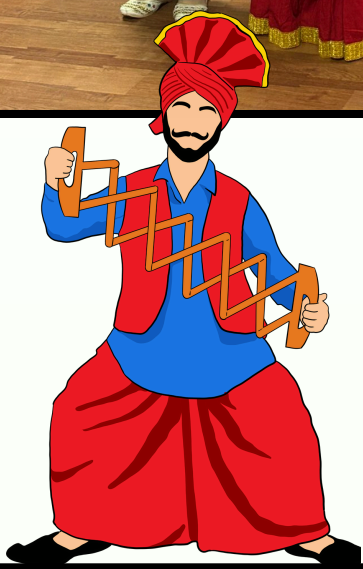

◆ The Marketing Campaign (Intra-School Competition)

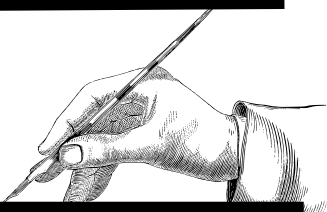
